#### UN TRAINING CENTRE OF THE GERMAN ARMED FORCES IN HAMMELBURG

With the creation of a “Training Platform for Peace Operations” in November 2008, Germany has acknowledged its commitment to a comprehensive security network structure and multi-dimensional peacekeeping. The UN Training Centre of the German Armed Forces (Hammelburg), the Command and Staff College of the German Armed Forces (Hamburg), the three German police colleges (Lübeck, Brühl and Wertheim) and the Centre for International Peace Operations (ZIF) are united under this umbrella.

The platform facilitates regular dialogue, serves as information hub and creative cell for the development of joint training activities in preparation for future deployment to peace operations.

This course is part of our joint initiative, putting the integrated training approach into practice, based on the development of common training contents and an exchange of trainers and mentors to allow a diversified training approach.
